


Two-Wheelers (2W)

#### **Growth drivers included:**


- A high number of auspicious marriage days

# Market Share % Of Three-Wheeler OEM











# **Market Share % Of Commercial Vehicle OEM**


Liquidity issues

Sluggish commodity transport (cement, coal)


Geopolitical uncertainties







Near-Term Outlook - June 2025

Tailwinds:

Q4 FY25 GDP growth around 6.5%

CPI inflation trending toward RBI's 4% target

Monsoon forecast at 106% of long-period average – likely to boost rural sentiment

Anticipated 25 bps repo rate cut may ease financing

Recent 3% MSP hike on Kharif crops expected to improve farm incomes

55.46% of dealers expect flat volumes

31% expect growth

13.54% anticipate de-growth



## 🧩 Segment-Wise June Outlook:

2W: Likely to benefit from rural demand and festivals like Rath Yatra, but financing hurdles persist.

PV: High inventory and dated product portfolios are limiting conversions, despite healthy bookings.

CV: Inventory churn remains high; demand subdued due to liquidity crunch and early rains.



FADA's Recommendations:

**OEMs and financers must:** 

- Calibrate production to real market demand
- Offer well-targeted channel incentives
- Ensure adequate working capital support for dealers

Conclusion – June 2025 Outlook

The outlook is "Cautiously Optimistic."

Rural segments like 2W and tractors may continue to perform well.

However, PV and CV segments will likely face pressure due to inventory build-up, financing issues, and weak freight demand.

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
